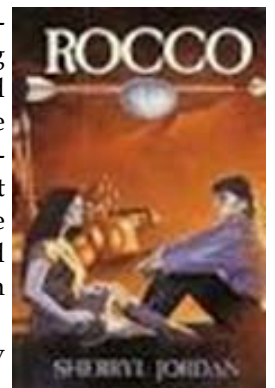


Try reading this
