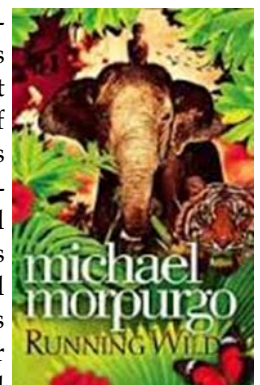
A shout out to Green Bay High School's band, Courtney Hate, who with the Kaipara band were the hits of the night with the audience.
