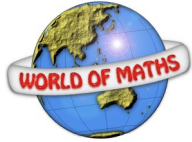

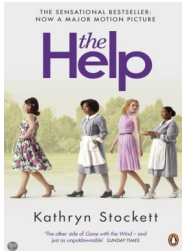

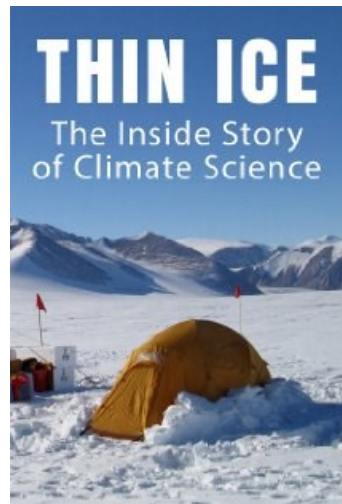


Follow these three very different women as they embark on a journey to change the world.

Watson and Injury specialist Sonya Binks for making the week happen!

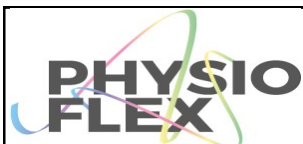


SOCCER
