## Romeo & Juliet

Enjoyment of Romeo and Juliet depends particularly on the performances of the cast. So much turns on the emotions that enjoyment of this well known Shakespeare classic relies on the power and energy that the cast brings to the characters.

You will enjoy this production. It is simply outstanding. Michael Brown and Imogen Roberts as Romeo and Juliet are both equally strong, bringing passion and tenderness to their roles so that the relationship is the powerful heart of the play. They are ably supported by a flamboyant Marc George as Mercutio, a loud and flighty Erica Cherton as the Nurse and great performances by Karl Simpson, Troy Studholme, Emma Gribble, Kavan Read-Hayes and Isaac Olsen. Former student Karlton Laing (2010) anchors the cast with a strong performance as Capulet.

The set is a skilful blend of levels and light so that scene changes are made seamlessly and the action proceeds smoothly to its dramatic climax.

College music students provide the sounds and the technical expertise for the production. They are directed by Year 13 student, Pearl Hindley, whose violin playing contributes wonderfully to the atmosphere of sixteenth century Verona. Director, Patrice Wilson, has done a marvelous job in drawing such focussed energy from her students.
