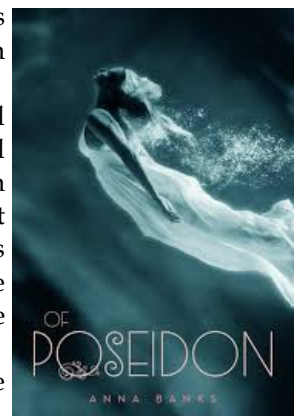
Of Poseidon
