Students rotated around a group of speakers that explored different aspects of driver awareness. All had different messages, thought producing games or experiences such as feeling what the force is like when stopping suddenly.

The most moving was the talk of a young man involved in an accident that was not his fault. Today he lives with paralysis. He cannot live on his own. His story was very relevant as the accident happened 10 years ago on Highway 16.

The students thought it was worthwhile, the organisers found our students interested, very engaged and polite. They were most complimentary. Thanks to Rotary, in particular the Waimauku club, who funded the whole day.
