The Kaipara College Girls Sevens team won the 2014 NHSS Open Girls title, defeating Northcote College 33-0 in the final. Kaipara College last won the title in 2011.

Earlier the team had won its two pool games comfortably, beating Long Bay College 43-5 and Hato Petera College 48-7. In the semi-final the Kaipara team defeated last year's champion school Mahurangi College easily, winning 47-0.
