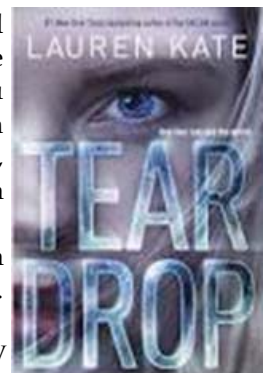
Nick Milina, owner of Helensville Hire, kindly lent us scaffolding so we could do some maintenance and light set ups for music and drama in the Hall.
