Entry Slips

All students have been given NCEA entry slips. These slips must be brought to each NCEA examination. If students have lost the entry slip, replacements can be obtained from Mr. Greenbrook.

Exam Timetable

All students have their examination timetable. Students: Highlight your exam times and put the examination timetable on the wall where you can see it. Replacement timetables can be obtained from the NZQA website, www.nzqa.govt.nz. There is a link on the bottom of the home page.

There is nothing we can do if students miss an examination because they got the time wrong.

Illness

If students become ill and cannot do an examination the school can apply for a derived grade on their behalf. This requires a medical certificate. So if a student is ill during the exam period please get a medical certificate and contact the school as soon as you can.

Results

Results are not mailed to students. Results are obtained on-line.

To do this students must have a log-in and password. Students were given their log-in number some time ago. If students do not know it or have lost it a replacement can only be obtained by phoning 04 802 3000 and asking for a replacement.
